Ms. Nobsch indicated that there have been prior disciplinary actions against Mr. Tehrani, including Consent Orders from 2017, 2018, and 2021.

After a brief discussion, Mr. Allen moved to amend the sanction for Count 1: 18VAC10-20-740.G.1 to a \$2500.00 monetary penalty and to suspend Mr. Tehrani's license for twelve (12) months. Ms. Anglin seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Alexander, Allen, Anglin, Arnold, Colley, Nair, Price, Reynes, Stiles, Stokes, and Townsend.

After a brief discussion, Ms. Anglin moved to amend the sanction for Count 2: 18VAC10-20-730.C to a \$2500.00 monetary penalty. Ms. Price seconded the motion. Mr. Allen requested a friendly amendment to the motion from monetary penalty to revocation of the license. After a brief discussion, Ms. Anglin and Ms. Price accepted the amendment and moved the motion to revocation of license. The motion was approved by members Alexander, Allen, Anglin, Arnold, Colley, Price, Reynes, Stiles, Stokes, and Townsend. Nair opposed the motion. The motion to amend the sanction for Count 2 to revocation of Mr. Tehrani's license passed with a vote of ten to one.

After a brief discussion, Ms. Anglin moved to accept the presiding officer's recommendation for no sanction for Count 3: 18VAC10-20-760.B.1. Ms. Stokes seconded the motion and was approved by: Alexander, Anglin, Arnold, Colley, Nair, Price, Reynes, Stiles, Stokes, and Townsend. Allen opposed the motion. The motion to accept the presiding officer's recommendation for Count 3 passed with a vote of ten to one.

The Board requested additional information on Mr. Tehrani to determine whether he practiced as a Professional Engineer license while on a prior suspension
