CLOSED SESSION

The Board convened on Wednesday, January 24, 2024, at 9:00 a.m., for the purpose of considering disciplinary cases related to teacher licensure. Dr. Seibert made a motion to enter into a Closed Session in accordance with § 2.2-3711 and 2.2-3712 of the Code of Virginia, under the following enumerated subsection:

Subsection 40: Discussion or consideration by the Board of Education of information relating to the denial, suspension, or revocation of teacher licenses subject to the exclusion in subdivision 11 of § 2.2-3705.3.

And that Deb Love and Abigail Gump, legal counsel to the Virginia Board of Education, as well staff members, whose presence would aid in this matter, participate in the closed meeting. The motion was properly seconded and carried unanimously. The Board went into closed session at 9:00 am. Dr. Seibert made a motion that the Board reconvened in open session.

Ms. Holton made a motion to issue the license in Case 03. The motion was properly seconded and carried unanimously.


Ms. Holton made a motion to suspend the license of Jovica Thomas Bristol for a period of two years. The motion was properly seconded and carried by majority with the following votes:
