## Re: Public Participation Guidelines (8 VAC 40-11)

Dear Dr. LaVista:
You ask whether the State Council of Higher Education possesses the requisite authority to promulgate the above-referenced regulations.

Va. Code Ann. § 23-9.6:1(15) vests the State Council of Higher Education with the authority to promulgate such regulations as may be necessary to carry out its powers and duties under the Code. Va. Code Ann. § 2.2-4007.02 mandates that each agency develop, adopt and use public participation guidelines.

I also find that the proposed regulations are consistent with the statutory grant of authority to promulgate them, are consistent with the statutes, and are internally consistent. The proposed regulations do not appear to run afoul of state or federal statutes. I further find that the proposed regulations have no Constitutional defect.
