Mandate and Impetus

A new Code section took effect on July 1, 2020, that provides that postsecondary schools that are certified by SCHEV may not condition the enrollment of a student on entering into an agreement that requires a student to arbitrate any dispute, or requires the student to resolve a dispute on an individual basis and waive the right to class or group action. Council staff determined that amendment of current regulations was necessary to conform to this change in the law and no agency discretion is involved. Therefore, action to amend the regulation is exempt pursuant to Virginia Code § 2.2-4006 A.
