The Virginia Racing Commission derives its statutory authority to promulgate regulations from the provisions of 59.1-369 of the Code of Virginia. The code states, in part, in subdivision 3, "The Commission shall promulgate regulations and conditions under which horse racing with pari-mutuel wagering shall be conducted in the Commonwealth, and all such other regulations it deems necessary and appropriate to effect the purposes of this chapter."

Purpose

The purpose of the proposed action is to specify certain procedures for the transfer or acquisition of an interest in an existing owner's, owner-operator's or operator's license. It is in the interest of horse racing and breeding within the Commonwealth that licensed racetracks are operated with the highest quality. This has provided for the safe conduct of the sport within Virginia and has ensured the facilities are safe for the patrons who attend the races.

The amendments specify certain procedures for the transfer or acquisition of an interest in an existing license. The changes are:

- 1. On the transfer of a race meet or meetings, the commission shall act within sixty days of receiving the request;
- 2. Any person acquiring actual control of an existing license shall apply to the commission for approval;
- 3. The Commission may demand such information of the applicant and shall approve or deny the request within sixty days;
- 4. For person acquiring actual control of an existing license, the applicant must provide the following:

a. A proposal for the future operation of the license;

b. Additional information provided by the applicant; and

- c. The applicant has the experience, expertise, financial responsibility and commitments to meet the requirements of the Act, regulations, contracts with horsemen, and any proposal submitted by the commission.
- 5. For those applicants who have not sought commission approval, it may take actions against the existing licensee.
