Subject:	Letter of Assurance for 18 VAC 80-20, 18 VAC 80-30 Amendments to Incorporate Changes from Marijuana Legalization

I have reviewed the Board for Hearing Aid Specialists and Opticians amendments to the Hearing Aid Specialists' Regulations. In my view, as counsel to the Board for Hearing Aid Specialists and Opticians, the Board may promulgate these regulations pursuant to \$54.1-113 of the Code of Virginia. This amendment is further appropriate for exempt action pursuant to \$2.2-4006(A)(4)(a). The regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect. This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
