Letter of Assurance for Exempt Action Revising Public Participation Guidelines

I have reviewed the proposed Public Participation Guidelines, 18 VAC 62-10-10 *et seq.* by the Fair Housing Board (the "Board"). In my view, as counsel to the Virginia Fair Housing Board, the Board may promulgate these regulations, pursuant to §§ 2.2-4007.02, 54.1-201, 54.1-2344, and 36-96.8 of the *Code of Virginia*. The proposed regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law.

Further, adoption of the above Regulations is exempt from the provisions of the Virginia Administrative Process Act, §§ 2.2-4000, *et seq.* of the *Code of Virginia*, pursuant to Chapter 321 of the 2008 Virginia Acts of Assembly [HB 1167].

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
