Subject: Letter of Assurance for Proposed Regulations – Common Interest Community Management Information Fund Regulations – Continuation of Association Renewal Fee Reduction found at 18 VAC 48-60-60

I have reviewed the Common Interest Community Board's Common Interest Community Management Information Fund Regulations – Continuation of Association Renewal Fee Reduction found at 18 VAC 48-60-60 that was posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall on December 15, 2015. In my view, as counsel to the Common Interest Community Board, these regulations may be promulgated pursuant to Title 54.1 of the Code of Virginia. The regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appeal to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect. Further, I certify that the proposed changes are exempt from the Administrative Process Act under <u>Code of Virginia §§ 2.2-4006(A)(6)</u> as the changes are "regulations of the regulatory boards served by... (ii) the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation or the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Title 54.1 [and] that are limited to reducing fees charged to regulants and applicants."
