SUBJECT: Regulations Governing the Practice of Physician Assistants

18VAC85-50-10 et seq.

I have reviewed the amendments to the *Regulations Governing the Practice of Physician Assistants*, 18VAC85-50-10, *et seq.* The proposed amendments change requirements for physician assistant practice agreements consistent with changes in the Code of Virginia following the passage of 2016 Va. Acts, Chapter 450. These proposed amendments are exempt from the operation of the Virginia Administrative Process Act and review by the Executive Branch in accordance with Virginia Code § 2.2-4006(A)(4)(a), which provides an exemption for regulations "[n]ecessary to conform to changes in Virginia statutory law or the appropriation act where no agency discretion is involved." Va. Code § 2.2-4006(A)(4)(a). The Board of Medicine has the statutory authority to amend these Regulations under Virginia Code § 54.1-2400. The proposed amendments are constitutional and do not conflict with existing federal or state laws or regulations.
