Subject: Memorandum of Authority for Proposed Amendments to Regulations Pertaining To Health Requirements Governing the Control of Equine Infectious Anemia in Virginia, 2 VAC 5-70 *et seq.*

I reviewed the proposed amendments to the Regulations Pertaining To Health Requirements Governing the Control of Equine Infectious Anemia in Virginia, particularly 2 VAC 5-70-20 and 2 VAC 5-70-30, by the Board of Agriculture and Consumer Services (hereinafter "Board"). In my view, as counsel to the Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, the Board has authority to promulgate these regulations, pursuant to § 3.2-6002 of the *Code of Virginia*. The proposed regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law.

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
