SUBJECT: Rules Relating to Compulsory Minimum Training Standards for Jailors,

Courthouse and Courtroom Security Officers, and Process Service

(6 VAC 20-50)

In response to a request from the Department of Criminal Justice Services, I have reviewed the proposed regulations, 6 VAC 20-50, relating to the Compulsory Minimum Training Standards for Jailors, Courthouse and Courtroom Security Officers, and Process Service. Section 9.1-102 of the *Code of Virginia* gives the Criminal Justice Services Board the authority to promulgate regulations it deems necessary and appropriate to administer compulsory minimum, entry-level, inservice, and advanced training standards compulsory minimum, entry-level, inservice, and advanced training standards. Upon review of the aforesaid regulations, I find the proposed regulations to be constitutional, consistent with the statutory authority granted by § 9.1-102 of the *Code of Virginia*, and in conformity with existing statutory provisions.
