## **MEMORANDUM**

- SUBJECT: Regulation Relating to the Compulsory Minimum Standards for Criminal Justice Instructors 6 VAC 20-80-20

In response to a request from the Department of Criminal Justice Services, I have reviewed the proposed regulation, 6 VAC 20-80-20, relating to compulsory minimum standards for criminal justice instructors. Virginia Code § 9.1-102(15) requires the Department to establish compulsory minimum qualifications of certification and recertification for instructors in criminal justice training schools approved by the Department. Virginia Code § 9.1-102(1) requires the Department to adopt regulations, pursuant to the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.), for the administration of this chapter. Upon review of the aforesaid regulation, I find the proposed regulation to be constitutional, consistent with the statutory authority granted by Virginia Code §§ 9.1-102(1) and 9.1-102(15) of the Code of Virginia, and in conformity with existing statutory provisions.
