**Subject:** Letter of Assurance for Amendments to the Enterprise Zone Grant Program Regulation, 13 VAC 5 □ 112

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I have reviewed the Board of Housing and Community Development's proposed Amendments to the Enterprise Zone Grant Program Regulation, 13 VAC 5 □ 112 as posted to the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall. In my view, as counsel to the Board of Housing and Community Development, the Board may amend these regulations pursuant to § 59.1-541 of the *Code of Virginia*. In addition, this action is exempt from Article 2 of the Administrative Process Act pursuant to § 2.2-4006 of the *Code of Virginia*. The regulations and amendments do not appear, on their face, to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with federal or state law currently in effect.

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
