The Congregate Housing Program Guidelines regulation was adopted by the Department of Housing and Community Development to provide guidelines for the operation of the Congregate Housing Program that was funded through the Virginia Housing Partnership Revolving Fund pursuant to Section 36-141 et seq. of the Code of Virginia. The use of the Virginia Housing Partnership Revolving Fund for providing housing assistance has substantially changed since 1990 and this program is no longer funded by the Partnership Fund and is no longer an active state program. The Department has determined that there is no need for this state regulation and has approved the repeal of the regulation.
