**RE:** Review of “Regulatory action to reflect updated Code of Virginia related to qualifications for mineral mine inspectors” (amending 4VAC25-35-40) (Action 6845)

---

In response to a request from the Virginia Department of Energy (“Department”), I have reviewed the above-referenced regulations of the Department.

The Department has the authority to amend its regulations. *See* Va. Code §§ 45.2-103, 45.2-1202. After reviewing the proposed amendments, it is my opinion that the Department has the authority to amend and reissue the above-referenced regulations. The proposed amendments do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect.

Furthermore, this proposed regulatory amendment is necessary to conform to changes in Virginia statutory law, and no agency discretion is involved. *See* 2025 Acts of Assembly Chapters

390 and 405. Accordingly, this regulation is exempt from Article 2 of the Administrative Process Act (Va. Code §§ 2.2-4000 et seq.). *See* Va. Code § 2.2-4006(A)(4)(a).
