By communication from Stephen A. Walz, Agency Regulation Coordinator, I am advised that, pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia CODE § 2.2-4000, *et seq.*, the Department of Mines, Minerals and Energy (the "Department") intends to promulgate proposed final regulation 4 VAC 25-35 (the "Proposed Regulation") amending existing regulation 4 VAC 25-35 (Certification Requirements for Mineral Miners). You have asked that I provide you with a determination of whether statutory authority exists to promulgate the Proposed Regulation.

After review of the Proposed Regulation, it is my opinion that the Department has authority to promulgate the Proposed Regulation under applicable law, including Va. **CODE** § 45.1-161.292:19.
