During the 2020 Session of the General Assembly, the legislature enacted Chapters 477, 1137 and 1140 which amended the Virginia Fair Housing Law (§ 36-96.1 et seq. of the Code of Virginia), effective July 1, 2020. The Real Estate Board and the Fair Housing Board are updating their regulations to conform to the statutory changes.

The regulations being amended (18 VAC 135-50 et seq.) contain language adding four new protected classes, conforming the relevant regulations to the amended Code of Virginia. The boards are promulgating this regulatory action to conform the regulations to the law and there is no agency discretion pursuant to § 2.2-4006.A.4.a of the Code of Virginia.
