I have reviewed the Department of Labor and Industry's proposed Amended Regulations for Final Rule on the Clarification of Employers' Continuing Obligation to Make and Maintain an Accurate Record of Each Recordable Injury and Illness found at — 16VAC25-85-1904.0, 16VAC25-85-1904.4, 16VAC25-85-1904.29, 16VAC25-85-1904.32, 16VAC25-85-1904.33, 16VAC25-85-1904.34, 16VAC25-85-1904.35, and 16VAC25-85-1904.40 that was posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall on June 26, 2018. In my view, as counsel to the Department of Labor and Industry, these regulations may be promulgated pursuant to Title 40.1 of the Code of Virginia. Further, I certify that the proposed changes are exempt from the Administrative Process Act under <u>Code of Virginia</u> §§ 2.2-4006(A)(4)(c) as they are necessary to meet the requirements of federal law or regulations and they do not materially differ from those required by federal law or regulation.
