Re: Proposed Amendments to Regulations Governing High School Adult Programs (8 VAC 20-30-10 et seq.)

Dear Dr. DeMary:

You ask whether the Virginia Board of Education possesses the requisite statutory authority to promulgate the above proposed amendments to its Regulations Governing High School Adult Programs, 8 VAC 20-30-10 *et seq.*

Article 3 of Chapter 13 of Title 22.1 of the Code of Virginia (§§ 22.1-223 through 22.1-226) addresses adult education. Section 22.1-225 requires local school boards to provide adult education programs, and § 22.1-224(1) directs the Board of Education to require the development of such programs. In addition, subsection (3) directs the Board to "[p]romulgate appropriate standards and guidelines for adult education programs. . . ." The Board has issued the above-mentioned regulations, and now seeks to amend them.

Code § 22.1-224 grants the Board of Education sufficient statutory authority to promulgate the proposed regulations (and, by implication, to amend them). I have reviewed the proposed changes, and in my judgment the amendments are within the authority delegated to the Board of Education.
