1 MR. BELL: Good morning, ladies and
2 gentlemen. I am Ken Bell. I am the Chairman of
3 the Cemetery Board.

4 This is a public hearing held at the
5 Department of Profession and Occupational
6 Regulation, 3600 West Broad Street, Richmond,
7 Virginia. This hearing is being held pursuant to
8 2.2-4007 of the Administrative Process Act of the
9 Code of Virginia for the purpose of receiving
10 public comment on the Board's proposed regulations
11 published in the Virginia Register on Monday,
12 September 4, 2006.

13 The list of interested parties and
14 organizations which were notified of this process
15 and invited to comment is available upon written
16 request.

17 The staff of the Department of Professional
18 and Occupational Regulation will prepare a report
19 of all public comment received which will be
20 presented to the Board for consideration of any
21 revisions to the proposed regulations.

22 Please allow me to introduce the members of
23 the Cemetery Board at this time. They are Randy
24 Gleason and Mike Kirsch, and I'm Ken Bell.

25 Now I would like to present the rules for

1 this public hearing:

2 Comments will be received from any member
3 of the public and initial comments will be limited
4 to a maximum of five minutes, depending on the
5 number of individuals who wish to speak. If you
6 have not signed up to speak and you wish to give
7 testimony today, please sign your name on the
8 sign-up sheet at this time.

9 We will be using the light box this morning
10 to assist you in being aware of the allotted five
11 minutes. The green light will be on for the first
12 four minutes, the yellow light will come on when
13 one minute remains and then the red light will
14 come on when the five minutes are up and your
15 testimony will need to end.

16 Board members may ask speakers questions or
17 to clarify statements. However, this is not the
18 proper forum for questions to the Board. If you
19 have a question for the Board, please forward
20 them, in writing, to the Board.

21 Any speaker who wishes to provide a written
22 statement, in addition to his oral testimony or in
23 lieu of oral testimony, may do so until Friday,
24 November 3, 2006.

25 NOTE: At this point, no members of the

1 public appeared to give comment.

2 MR. BELL: Thank you for your comments
3 today. The record of the public hearing will be
4 kept open until Friday, November 3, 2006, and
5 written comment will be accepted through 5:00 p.m.
6 that day.
