



VOSH PROGRAM DIRECTIVE: 01-007

ISSUED: December 1, 1994

SUBJECT: Cancellation of Selected VOSH Program Directives

A. Purpose.

This directive informs the field personnel that federal OSHA has cancelled numerous instructions which, in turn, have a significant impact on many VOSH Program Directives. As a result, VOSH is using this program directive to cancel the group of VOSH program directives which have been affected.

This Program Directive is an internal guideline, not a statutory or regulatory rule, and is intended to provide instructions to VOSH personnel regarding internal operation of the Virginia Occupational Safety and Health Program and is solely for the benefit of the program. This document is not subject to the Virginia Register Act or the Administrative Process Act; it does not have general application and is not being enforced as having the force of law.

B. Scope.

This directive applies to all VOSH personnel.

E. Action.

Directors and Supervisors shall assure that field personnel comply with the provisions of this program directive.
