VOSH PROGRAM DIRECTIVE: 02-209

ISSUED: April 15, 1993

SUBJECT: Fixed Ladders Used on Outdoor Advertising Structures/Billboards
in the Outdoor Advertising Industry.

A. Purpose.

This Directive transmits the policies and provides enforcement guidelines to field personnel for standards relating to fixed ladders used on outdoor advertising, §§1910.27(d)(1)(ii) and 1910.27(d)(2).

This Program Directive is an internal guideline, not a statutory or regulatory rule, and is intended to provide instructions to VOSH Personnel regarding internal operation of the Virginia Occupational Safety and Health Program and is solely for the benefit of the program. This document is not subject to the Virginia Register Act or the Administrative Process Act; it does not have general application and is not being enforced as having the force of law.

B. Scope.

This Directive applies to all VOSH personnel and specifically to Occupational Safety Enforcement and Voluntary Compliance personnel.
