



VOSH PROGRAM DIRECTIVE: 02-424

ISSUED: September 15, 1991

SUBJECT: Indoor Air Quality

A. Purpose.

This directive establishes compliance policy for dealing with Complaints regarding indoor air quality problems and transmits guidelines to be used in the evaluation of indoor air quality conditions.

B. Scope.

This directive applies to all VOSH Personnel and specifically to Occupational Health Enforcement and Voluntary Compliance.
