

STATEMENT ON THE USE OF VDOT COUNTY MAP SERIES DIGITAL FILES

VDOT's digital data files, used to publish its county map series, are available to the public. Using ArcView® and ARC/INFO® software, the users of this CD have access to creative, value-added files and features that VDOT uses to make its published maps distinctive and copyrightable, such as symbology and distance annotation. **Use of these copyrightable files or data layers indicates agreement to abide by all copyright laws and restrictions regarding the files. The copyrightable files and hard-copy maps developed from the files may not be duplicated, sold or distributed without written permission from VDOT.**

VDOT is to be credited as the source of the base data through a copyright notice that includes the date. If the data are used to create new files that are sold, the customers must be advised in advance of the sale that the base data are available for free from VDOT.

VDOT has ongoing update and quality control procedures for the files. Updated versions of the County Map Series files will be announced by VDOT when they become available.

VDOT welcomes verifiable corrections to any significant errors that are found in the data. Corrections should be provided with metadata and if possible in the same format in which VDOT provided the original files and/or in a well-documented hard copy. Send corrections to the information contact (see below).

VDOT prefers to be the distributor of the data to ensure the files' accuracy and timeliness. VDOT will be able to answer questions about the files only from persons or organizations that received them directly from the official VDOT distributor (see contact information below).

Warranties and Liability: These data and metadata are used for internal purposes by VDOT. Once the data are distributed outside of the agency, VDOT assumes no responsibility to maintain the data or metadata for the recipient in any manner or form. The data and metadata are provided "as is" and in no event shall the Commonwealth of Virginia, or its agencies or representatives, be liable for any damages, including but not limited to, damages resulting from lost data or lost profits or revenue, the costs of recovering such data, the costs of substitute data, claims by third parties, other similar costs, or any special, incidental, punitive, or consequential damages arising out of the use of the data.

The accuracy, validity, or reliability of the data or metadata is not guaranteed or warranted in any way. The Commonwealth of Virginia and its agencies and representatives disclaim all warranties, express or implied, including but not limited to liability for quality, performance, merchantability, and fitness for a particular purpose arising out of the use of or inability to use the data. ***Recipients of the data are expected to save and maintain the metadata to ensure that complete and accurate documentation of the data is always available.***

OVERVIEW OF VDOT'S COUNTY MAP SERIES DIGITAL FILES
September 1999

The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) distributes statewide geo-spatial databases on its maintained highway transportation network. These files were created in an ARC/INFO® Librarian environment, and can be displayed, queried, and manipulated using ARC/INFO®, ArcView®, or ArcExplorer® GIS software. VDOT is sharing the files at no charge to enhance the accuracy, timeliness and usefulness of information developed and used by VDOT and others, which ultimately benefits Virginia's citizens, businesses and visitors. This edition reflects the state-maintained highway system as of December 31 1997 in approximately 64 counties throughout the state. The remainder of the counties are current as of July 1, 1995. A list of counties that have been edited since the previous CD release can be found in the documentation metadata files.

The files are available on CD-ROM in two versions. The details are outlined below.
