The meeting was called to order by Ms. Cartte. With nine (9) members of the Board of Nursing participating, a quorum was established.

Avi Efreom, Adjudication Specialist, presented evidence that the continued practice as a nurse aide by **Dominique T. Dorsey, CNA (1401-243087)** may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

Ms. Davis moved to summarily suspend the certificate of **Dominique T. Dorsey** to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia and to offer a consent order for revocation of her certificate in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded by Dr. Cox and carried unanimously.

Mr. Efreom left the meeting at 4:38 p.m.

Elizabeth Dorsey, Adjudication Specialist, presented evidence that the continued practice as a nurse aide by **Chenoa G. Hughes, CNA (1401-227260)** may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

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Ms. Davis moved to summarily suspend the certificate of **Chenoa G. Hughes** to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia and to offer a consent order for revocation of her certificate and enter a Finding of Abuse against her in the Virginia Nurse Aide Registry in lieu of a formal hearing. The motion was seconded by Dr. Cox and carried unanimously.
