
- CALL TO ORDER:** A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 1:00 p.m.

- MATTER:** **Brian Cable** **License No.: FSL Applicant**

- DISCUSSION:** Mr. Cable appeared before the Committee in person in accordance with a Notice of the Board dated March 22, 2023. Mr. Cable was not represented by counsel.
- The Committee fully discussed the allegations in the Notice with Mr. Cable.
- CLOSED SESSION:** Upon a motion by Mr. Nelsen. and duly seconded by Ms. Mimms, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Mr. Cable. Additionally, he moved that Ms. Tillman Wolf and Ms. Venable attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.
- RECONVENE:** Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of. The Code, the Committee re-convened in open session and announced its decision.

**DECISION:** Upon a motion by Ms. Mimms, and duly seconded by Mr.. Nelsen, the Committee made certain findings of fact and conclusions of law and voted to issue an **Order to Approve** Mr. Cable application for registration as a Funeral Licensee, **Contingent upon successful completion of state exam.**

**VOTE:** The vote was unanimous.

**ADJOURNMENT:** The Committee adjourned at 1:32 p.m.

*As provided by law this decision shall become a Final Order thirty (30) days after service of such Order on Mr. Cable, unless a written request to the Board for a formal hearing on the allegations made against him is received from Mr. Cable, within such time. If service of the Order is made by mail three (3) additional days shall be added to that period. Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the decision of the Special Conference Committee shall be vacated.*
