The meeting was called to order by Mr. Jones. With 8 members of the Board of Nursing participating, a quorum was established.

James Schliessmann, Assistant Attorney General, presented evidence that the continue practice as a registered medication aide by **DeAnne Marie Wilmouth (0031-005875)** may present a substantial danger to the health and safety of the public.

**CLOSED MEETING:** Dr. Smith moved that the Board of Nursing convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711(A)(27) of the Code of Virginia at 4:11 P.M., for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of **DeAnne Marie Wilmouth**. Additionally, Dr. Smith moved that Ms. Douglas, Dr. Hills, Ms. Morris, Ms. Bargdill, Ms. Vu and Ms. Mitchell attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting is deemed necessary and their presence will aid the Board in its deliberations. The motion was seconded by Mr. Monson and carried unanimously.

**RECONVENTION:** The Board reconvened in open session at 4:21 P.M.

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Dr. Smith moved that the Board of Nursing certify that it heard, discussed, or considered only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion by which the closed meeting was convened. The motion was seconded by Dr. Gleason and carried unanimously.

Mr. Monson moved to summarily suspend the right to renew the medication aide registration of **DeAnne Marie Wilmouth** pending a formal administrative hearing and to offer a consent order for indefinite suspension of her right to renew her registration in lieu of a formal hearing for a period of not less than two years. The motion was seconded by Dr. Gleason and carried unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:23 P.M.
