



MINUTES

- CALL TO ORDER:** A Special Conference Committee ("Committee") of the Board of Psychology ("Board") convened on December 5, 2016, at 10:05 a.m. at the Department of Health Professions, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Richmond, VA, Hearing Room 3.

- DISCUSSION:** Dr. Wong appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in accordance with a notice dated November 10, 2016, to review her petition for termination of the probation imposed on her license to practice school psychology in the Commonwealth of Virginia which was imposed by an Order of the Board entered September 30, 2014. The Committee fully discussed the allegations contained in the Notice with Dr. Wong.
- CLOSED MEETING:** Dr. Ball moved that the Committee convene in a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711(A)(27) of the *Code of Virginia* for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Margaret Wong, Ph.D., Licensed School Psychologist. Additionally, he moved that Jennifer Lang and Emily Tatum attend the closed meeting because their presence would aid the Committee in its deliberations. The motion was seconded and passed.
- RECONVENE:** Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee reconvened in open session and announced its decision.
- DECISION:** Upon a motion by Dr. Ball, and duly seconded by Dr. Werth, the Committee voted to approve Dr. Wong's request to terminate probation.
- ADJOURNMENT:** With all business concluded, the Committee adjourned at 11:01 a.m.
