- 1. Meeting Called to Order: Committee Chairman Kevin Hodges called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.
- 2. **New Business**: Mr. Hodges provided the committee members with an overview of the issue for discussion. The purpose of the committee was to discuss the recent removal of the photographs from the private security services registration cards and what recommendations if any the committee wished to offer to the full Board for consideration of presenting a final recommendation to the Criminal Justice Services Board and the Department of Criminal Justice Services.

The discussion included the following:

- A photo-id should be issued, in today's age, terrorism, lone wolf attacks, etc. supports the need for added security.
- Recommendation that the issue be addressed through legislation. Concerns over the Department's failure to respond to requests to reinstate the photo ID.
- The registration should contain a photo of the individual and clearly reflect the issuing government agency.
- Example provided that some companies issue a business photo ID, but still support a photo registration to be issued by the Department.

It was further discussed that legislation would most likely be introduced during the 2015 General Assembly and a recommendation that the Committee Chair, Kevin Hodges, meet with the Agency Director, Ms. Ecker to discuss the issue and allow for open communication between the Committee and the Department. Chairman Hodges would also provide a full report to the PSSAB at the next scheduled meeting.

- 3. Public Comment: There were no public comments offered.
- 4. **Adjournment**: Mr. Hodges moved to adjourn the meeting. With no objections, the meeting was adjourned at 12:00 p.m.
