Motion made and a seconded to not approve these changes. Sections to remain as amended in 2017.

- 3. As of July 1, 2021, the Code of Virginia simple possession of marijuana code 18.2-250.1 has been changed to a civil offense and is no longer a criminal offense thereby is no longer a consideration when reviewing criminal histories for EMS.
- 4. Exemption Request review
- Sections 1240 (BLS) & 1250 (ALS) minimum staffing requirements
- Agency provides Supplemented and Neonatal transports as well as standard BLS & ALS ambulance transports over the past 40 years. However, they have routinely utilized the RN as the AIC of all transports regardless of acuity.
- All ambulance transports are staffed with a team of 3 (RN, RT, and Paramedic)
- Even though RN's & RT's are full time employees of the transport service they are not trained to operate the ambulance.
- Discussion Points:

AIC should be treated the same as air medical crews

Need to train all staff to be able to competently utilize their equipment (ambulance)

Committee recommends denial of this request as it does not meet 12VAC5-31-140A.2 failed to demonstrate a genuine need for exemption.

- Motion Carried to recommend denial of this request
- 5. Exemption on Drug Box
 - Exemption request for drug boxes on fire engines to not contain all required medications authorized for use by provider per 12VAC5-31-860.D.1.a and D.2.d
 - Rationale is a lack of refrigerated space on Fire Engines
 - Committee consideration is that this could cause a hindrance of care by provider staffing the fire engine and first on scene.
 - Motion Carried to recommend denial of this request
