#### Re: Materials for the 2023 RAP (June 20, June 27, July 11)

Thank you for accepting the invitation to provide technical assistance to this office as a member of this year's reiteration of the Regulatory Advisory Panel regarding the "overhaul" of the department's licensing regulations. It is an understatement to say it is a significant undertaking to develop drafts for five service-specific chapters with an overarching general administrative chapter and to combine the current Childrens Residential Regulations [12VAC35-46] with the other licensing chapter, Rules and Regulations for Licensing Providers by the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services [12VAC35-105]. In addition to comments received through public comment forums, your requested technical guidance on specific matters in these draft regulatory chapters will be most helpful to the final product.

#### **Targeted Discussion**

The amendments you see in these drafts reflect what the 2019 RAP recommended, and input from both comments received from general notice forums and internal staff subject matter experts. As explained in your invitation to the RAP, the three meetings will cover a targeted list of questions on which DBHDS seeks assistance for further refinement of draft language.

Covering the targeted list of questions is the priority for these meetings. However, if you have recommendations to suggest that point to language that might be eliminated or reduced, we plan to address those at the end of the third meeting. Also, please keep in mind that once submitted to the State Board of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services for formal action (currently planned for December), additional comment forums will be part of the official regulatory process. In other words, the RAP is not the last time to provide feedback.

## **Other Licensing Regulatory Projects**

It is important to mention that simultaneous efforts are underway to meet the Administration's requirements to reduce regulatory requirements and streamline regulatory language while ensuring the health, safety, and welfare of some of Virginia's most vulnerable citizens. Over the past several months, this office prioritized draft actions for reduction of current mandates that are considered 'low hanging fruit,' noncontroversial edits (currently planned for September). Some language currently in regulation and still in the overhaul drafts may be suggested for inclusion in the 'low hanging fruit' actions to be removed or reduced in intensity of burden. This may seem redundant, but I hope to see the overhaul drafting effort completed as initiated a few years ago as the process is close to fruition. Then, a fresh eye can be applied to having the language comply with the current gubernatorial requirements in Executive Directive 1 and Executive Order 19 for all regulations. Across all of these proposed regulatory changes, my highest priority is to ensure the system remains understandable, stable, and functional for providers, staff, individuals needing or receiving services, and family members.

## Logistics

I look forward to speaking with you next week. A number of you have alternates assigned in case you are not able to attend a meeting and they are set as panelists in Zoom. However, both will not be serving as a panelist at the same meeting as that would be double coverage. Good technical assistance from you and your organization is vital, yet the volume can become unwieldy and time overall is limited to cover a number of important items. ## **Background**

Each state agency must ensure that its regulations are reviewed at least once every four years through a "periodic review." Agencies must then decide if the regulation will be amended, retained as is, or repealed. After conducting a periodic review of the Licensing Regulations, the agency filed a decision to amend the regulations. In 2019, a public comment forum and a RAP were held to discuss the <u>revision of the Licensing</u> Regulations General Chapter.

## **Planned Changes**

Since the development of the draft General Chapter, the Office of Licensing has worked steadily on the "overhaul" of the Licensing Regulations and developed drafts for five new service-specific chapters:

- Case Management
- Center-Based Services
- Home/Non-Center Based Services
- Residential Services
- Crisis Services

The department received <u>public comment via Town Hall</u> on the first four of these chapters in 2021 and 2022. The draft of the new Crisis Services Chapter, the fifth and

final service-specific chapter, will be available on Town Hall for public comment this spring 2023. Note that current drafts intend to incorporate the requirements of the current Chapter 46 (12VAC35-46), Regulations for Children's Residential Facilities.

# **RAP Membership and Public Comment**

- Membership on the RAP is by invitation. Individuals from state agency partners and providers around the state are being invited to have balanced representation.
- The meetings will be formal in nature and open to the public.
- The draft text under review by the RAP will be posted concurrently on Town Hall in a public comment forum and sent to all providers as required by § 2.2-4007.04:01.C. of the Code of Virginia.

# Response to Periodic Review versus Regulatory Actions in Process

It is important to distinguish this drafting effort of the response to periodic review of the Licensing Regulations from other current discussions regarding regulatory actions in process.

- <u>Response to Periodic Review</u>: Draft changes for the response to periodic review will be in a separate action and are not expected to take effect until 2025 following the <u>standard process</u>, which takes an average of 18 months to two years to complete. These are only drafts at this time, no formal regulatory action has been filed.
- <u>Regulatory Actions in Process</u>: Current regulatory actions in process can be viewed <u>here</u> and are not related to the overhaul. The <u>current</u> <u>effective</u> Licensing Regulations will be the vehicle for any future department regulatory changes from this overhaul effort.
