A. Norfolk City Jail Renovation and Upgrade Project

Motion – The Board of Local and Regional Jails (APPROVES/DISAPPROVES) the Norfolk City Jail's request for state funding for the Medical Upgrades in their facility. This motion recognizes a total eligible cost of \$580,912.00 of which up to 25% or \$145,228.00 would be eligible for State reimbursement in a lump sum payment. Such

reimbursement is subject to the availability of funds and compliance with Board Standards for Planning, Design, Construction and Reimbursement of Local Correctional Facilities, 2018, and Sections 53.1-80 through 82 of the Code of Virginia.

B. Pamunkey Regional Jail Roof Renovation

Motion – The Board of Local and Regional Jails (APPROVES/DISAPPROVES) the Pamunkey Regional Jail’s request for state funding for the Roof Renovation at their facility. This motion recognizes a total eligible cost of \$2,260,000 of which up to 25% or \$565,000 would be eligible for State reimbursement in a lump sum payment. Such reimbursement is subject to the availability of funds and compliance with Board Standards for Planning, Design, Construction and Reimbursement of Local Correctional Facilities, 2018, and Sections 53.1-80 through 82 of the Code of Virginia.
